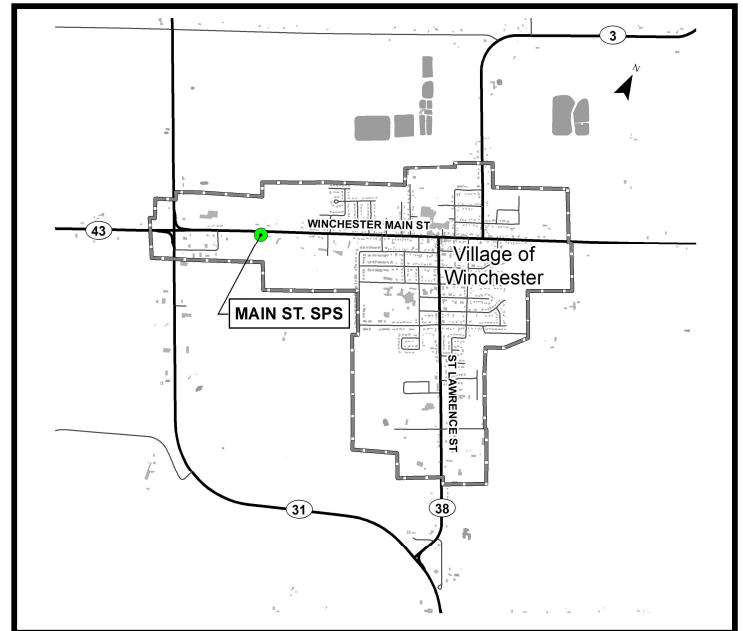
The Township of North Dundas Village of Winchester Main Street West Sewage Pump Station Upgrades Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment

The Township of North Dundas has initiated a Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to determine the most suitable option to renew the Main Street West Sewage Pump Station.

How Will This Affect Me?

The Class EA study is assessing various options to renew the Main Street West Sewage Pump Station in the Village of Winchester to ensure it can be relied on to accommodate current flows and the increase to flows that are anticipated from future growth within the upstream sewershed.

Public and agency consultation is a key part of the Class EA process. Based on your input, the Class EA study will identify a preferred option that will benefit the community over the long-term.



How Do I Get More Information?

A Public Information Centre will be held in early 2022 prior to confirming the preferred option. In the meantime, the study team will be reviewing background information and determining alternative options. You can contact a member of the study team listed below with any questions or to provide input on the Class EA study.

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This study is being conducted according to the requirements of a Schedule B project under the Ontario Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process (October 2000, as amended in 2015).
