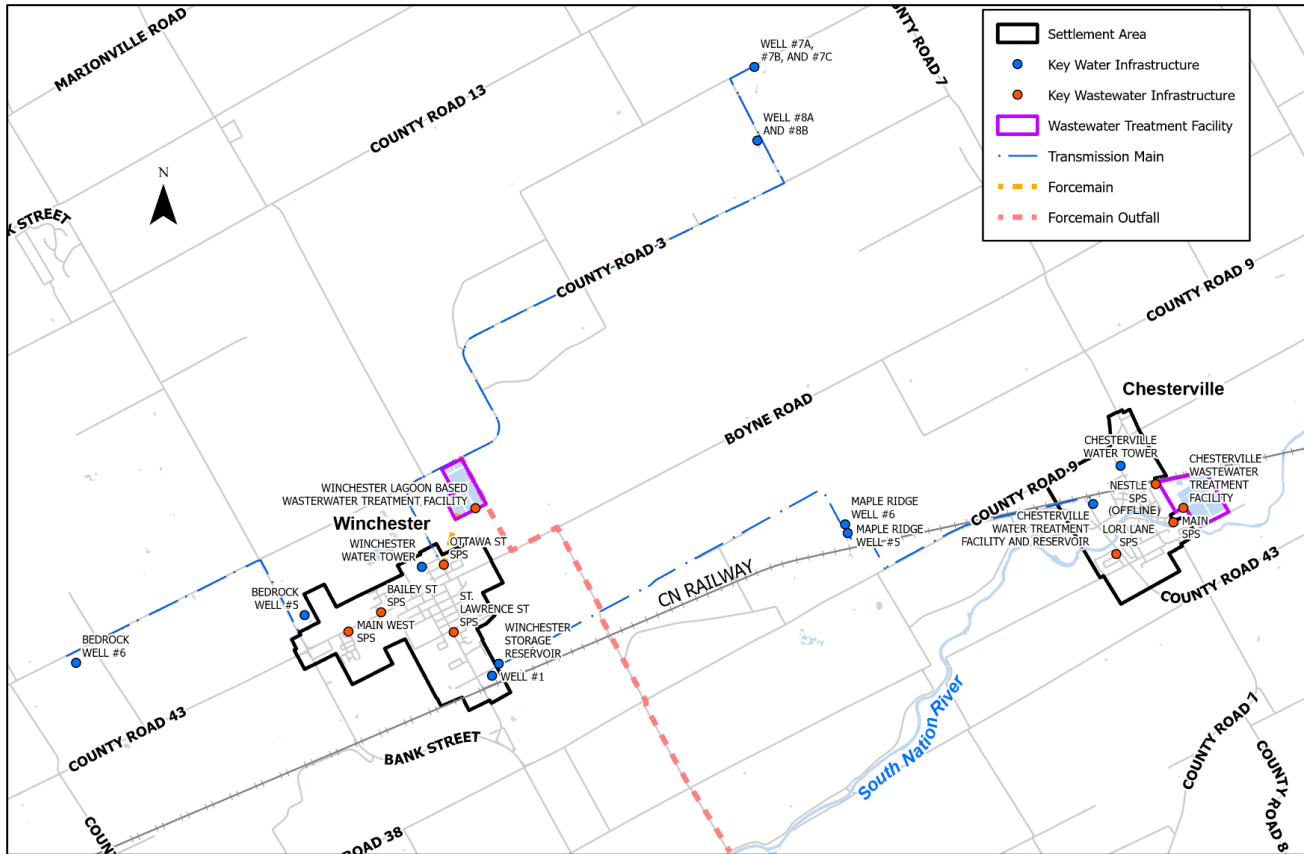


Notice of Study Commencement



Township of North Dundas Water and Wastewater Servicing Master Plan

The Township of North Dundas has initiated this study to evaluate the existing Winchester and Chesterville water and wastewater systems and identify required water and wastewater upgrades based on forecasted growth projections.



How Will This Affect Me?

The study will assess current and future requirements of the water and wastewater systems and develop preferred solutions to existing conditions and anticipated challenges, ultimately resulting in the development of a project implementation plan to guide the Township in planning future upgrades to the systems. Public, agency and indigenous consultation is a key element of the Master Plan process. Your input will help identify and evaluate preferred solutions that will support future growth and development.

How Do I Get More Information?

One (1) Public Information Centre (PIC) is proposed for Summer 2026, following the preparation of the draft Progress Report #2, outlining servicing opportunities and constraints and assessing alternative solutions.
